6. COVID ACCOUNTABILITY

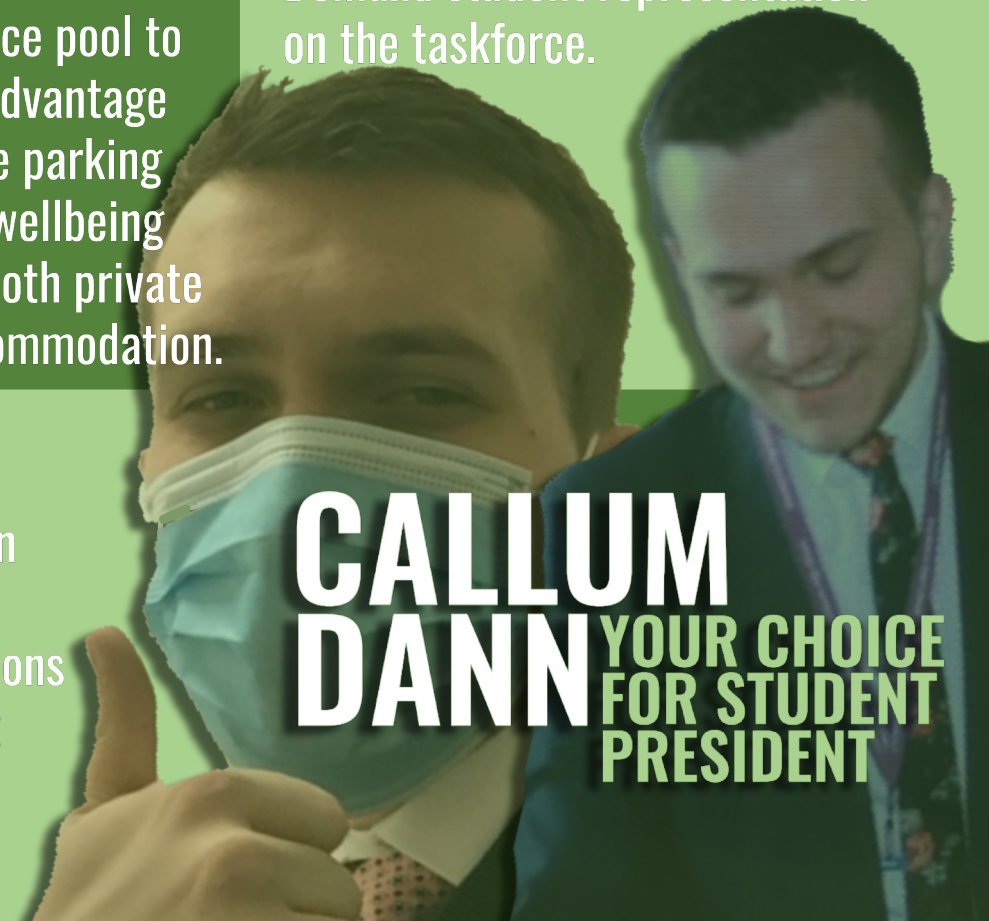
Demand student representation on the taskforce.
