

Student Officer Role Description

Excerpt from The Constitution and Rules of the Students' Union (Rule 4)

19. THE TRANS STUDENTS' OFFICER

They:

- 19.1 Shall self-define as a member of the Trans Student Community.
- 19.2 Shall be concerned with general issues relating to Transgender, Non-Binary, Intersex and Questioning Students. They shall also be responsible for liaison with organisations, both external and internal to the University, which are relevant to these Students.
- 19.3 Shall represent the interests of Transgender, Non-Binary, Intersex and Questioning Students to the Executive Management Committee and to the University Authorities, and shall campaign on issues that impact upon the student experience of these Students. They shall also draw attention to instances of discriminatory behaviour within the Union and the University whenever these occur.
- 19.4 Shall encourage greater involvement of Trans Students in Union affairs.
- 19.5 Shall be a voting member of the Students' Union Council and the Executive Management Committee.
