Student Officer Role Description

Excerpt from The Constitution and Rules of the Students' Union (Rule 4)

7. THE STUDENT OFFICER WELFARE

They:

- 7.1 Shall, insofar as it is possible, represent the interests of the Students in all matters relating to their welfare.
- 7.2 Shall be concerned with the general issues of accommodation, safety and wellbeing for Students.
- 7.3 Shall be responsible for liaison with the Students' Union Crèche and other campusbased childcare facilities, representing the interests of Students in these areas.
- 7.4 Shall be concerned with the general issues of financial hardship and legal aid and shall assist the Student Officer Undergraduate Education and Student Officer Postgraduate Education with regard to Student Support Meetings.
- 7.5 Shall be responsible for the compilation of the Welfare Section of Students' Union publications, where relevant.
- 7.6 Shall, in partnership with the Union President and the Student Officer Campaigns and Engagement, ensure good community cohesion and shall maintain good community relations, insofar as it is possible, with Residents' Groups and Associations in the South Belfast area.
- 7.7 Shall work in partnership with the Student Officer Campaigns and Engagement on campaigns related to student welfare.
- 7.8 Shall be a member of all relevant University Committees and groups.
